Boarding Policies

New Boarders: If we have never seen your pet before, the Veterinarian will need to examine your pet to establish a current patient-doctor relationship.

Vaccinations: To assure the protection of all pets under our care, the following vaccinations must be up to date or they will be given at your expense: **DOGS:** DHLPP (Distemper), Bordetella, CIV (Canine Influenza), Rabies. **CATS:** FVRCP (Distemper), Rabies. *We will accept a vaccine record or other written proof from another veterinarian.

Medical Illness: If your pet/s becomes ill while here, we will attempt to contact you or your agent at the phone number provided below. If no one can be reached, we will do what is deemed necessary to treat and charge appropriately.

Flea Treatment: All boarders will receive a Capstar 24-hour flea treatment on the day of pick-up. This is to prevent fleas from entering and exiting the kennel so that we can remain a flea-free practice.

Medications: All medications **MUST** be in their original packaging with appropriate drug labels. Repeat failure to comply will result in a repackaging fee of \$5.
